Below is a list of basic supplies for each grade level. Please remember that supplies will need to be replenished throughout the school year. We also ask that you label all items with a permanent marker. Please bring these supplies to Open House in August. Thank you!

2 composition notebooks 1 antibacterial hand gel 1 VINYL pocket folder (no prongs) 10 glue sticks – LARGE (.74 oz) 2 tubs disinfecting wipes 1 box washable markers 5 spiral notebooks – one subject each 3 packs #2 pencils (10-12 per pack) – no mechanical pencils 1 pack highlighters – yellow 1 pair scissors – youth size, NOT plastic 2 boxes of tissues 1 4-pack dry erase markers 1 set twistable colored pencils/crayons 1 set headphones or earbuds (inexpensive) in a ziplock bag, labeled with child's name 1 pack ziplock bags – gallon size 1 pack ziplock bags – sandwich size 2 packs lined paper (wide-ruled) 1 storage bin – quart size	1 3-ring binder 1 set of dividers 1 clipboard, standard size 1 box of crayons Glue sticks Highlighters 1 box of washable markers BLACK expo dry erase markers, chisel tip Loose-leaf paper (wide ruled) 1 spiral notebook #2 pencils 1 pair of scissors – child size, NOT plastic 1 plastic supply box, approx. 5x8 Box of tissues 1 pencil pouch that hooks into binder 1 set of headphones/earbuds Hand sanitizing gel Clorox wipes	1 pair of headphones 7 notebooks 7 folders 2 packs loose-leaf paper 2 poster boards (22x28) 5 packs of #2 pencils (10-12 per pack) 2 packs of pencil top erasers 4 large glue sticks 2 highlighters (different colors) 2 packs of 3x5 index cards 2 packs larger dry erase markers 1 zippered pencil pouch (no boxes) 1 box colored pencils (24 or less) 1 pack of washable markers 3 boxes of tissues 1 hand sanitizer gel – unscented 2 tub disinfecting wipes GIRLS ONLY: 1 pack ziplock bags – quart size BOYS ONLY: 1 pack ziplock bags – gallon size
